ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

The year 2005 witnessed significant strides in the Agency's steadfast commitment to sustain agricultural productivity through massive rehabilitation of irrigation systems and construction of projects which are essential in meeting the demands for agricultural development.

During the year, the Agency continued the implementation of 39 irrigation projects: 14 foreign-assisted national projects, 21 locally-funded projects and four inter-agency projects. Twelve (12) are located in Luzon, eight (8) in Visayas, six (6) in Mindanao, and thirteen (13) with subprojects in selected provinces nationwide.

Irrigation program for the year involved a funding requirement of P7,185M. Of the total available allotment of P6,327M, P4,984M was obligated and P3,265M was provided with cash and non-cash support.

The Agency generated 10,539 hectares (ha) new area and rehabilitated 110,865 hectares (ha) in existing systems. About 11,430 jobs were generated in the construction activities.

As of year-end, the total service area developed was 1.413M ha or 45% of the estimated potential irrigable area of 3.126M ha: 695,774 ha under 199 national irrigation systems (NIS); 543,262 ha in 7,144 communal irrigation systems (CIS) and 174,200 ha in private irrigation systems (PIS). The remaining potential area to be developed is 1.713 M ha.

The service area of NIS increased by 5,535 ha from the previous year's area with the partial operation of Malitubog-Maridagao Irrigation System in Cotabato and Maguindanao and Bubunawan Irrigation System in Bukidnon.

The total irrigated area was 1,531,290 ha: 972,692 ha for NIS and 558,598 ha for CIS.

The Agency's thrust to make Irrigators Associations (IA) effective and efficient partners of NIA in operating and maintaining irrigation systems continues to gain momentum. NIA organized, during the year, a total of 140 IA in both NIS and CIS nationwide with 15,951 farmer-members tilling 18,924 ha. Total IA organized now stands at 6,031 in all the NIS and CIS nationwide covering an area of 1,109,684 ha benefiting 735,879 farmers-members. NIA continued to provide assistance to IA in various aspects of their farming activities and community livelihood programs.

Several strategies were adopted by the Agency to enhance its services for a better physical assets management such as the adoption of the New Government Accounting System (NGAS), formulation of income generating policies on sale of idle real properties, lease of building and lots and housing projects for employees. NIA continued to implement reforms in procurement in accordance with the Government Procurement Reform Act to ensure efficiency and transparency in the procurement process.





The Agency continued to support the Energy Conservation Program of the government.

The Agency strove to generate as much income as it could. Revenues totaled P1.6B, higher by P200M in CY 2004. It posted net operating income of P104M from cash transactions. Irrigation Service Fee (ISF) collection, the primary source of income, reached P801M, an increase of P20M from the previous year.

One of the most significant programs of the agency to boost its collection of ISF back accounts is the Compromise Agreement Program. This program offered to farmers the payment of ISF back accounts that have piled up through the years without penalties and surcharges.

As in previous years, the Agency faced varied challenges, but the officials and employees have demonstrated the highest degree of professionalism and provided better public service to the farmers.

It is against this backdrop that as the Administrator of the NIA, I am confident that NIA will surpass whatever challenges it will face in the years ahead; that NIA will be able to perform its mandate as its contribution to Her Excellency, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo's program on rice self-sufficiency and alleviation of poverty through irrigation development.

PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION



Foreign-Assisted Projects

The Agency continued the implementation of fourteen ongoing foreign assisted projects. A total of P3,360M was programmed for these projects. This amounted to 73% of the total approved irrigation budget of P4,629M for CY 2005. At year end, total allotment released for these projects was P2,958M with corresponding cash/non-cash support of P574M. Obligations incurred amounted to P2,462M.

Moreover, carry-over funds of P361M which were unobligated from previous years allocation were utilized and obligated during the year. Hence, total available allotment amounted to P3,319M with corresponding cash/non-cash support of P660M. Total obligations incurred amounted to P2,823M.

Physical targets for these projects were the generation of 7,606 ha of new areas and the rehabilitation of 22,316 ha in existing irrigation systems. These targets represented 40% and 18% of the total target area of the Agency for generation and rehabilitation for CY 2005, respectively.

At year end, these projects generated 4,212 ha of new areas for irrigation and rehabilitated 20,549 ha in existing irrigation systems. Thus, the Agency's accomplishment is 55% and 92% of the total target area in foreign-assisted projects respectively.

Locally-Funded Projects

There were 15 locally-funded projects implemented during the year. Of the CY 2005 approved irrigation budget, 27% or P1,269M is programmed for these projects. Correspondingly, allotment released was P1,269M. Obligations incurred was P942M. Physical target for the year was the generation of 6,186 ha of new areas and rehabilitation of 97,443 ha in existing systems or 33% and 79% of the total Agency's targets for CY 2005.

As of the last quarter, these projects generated 1,809 ha of new areas and rehabilitated 72,074 ha in existing systems.

Total available allotment for these projects including carry-over funds from previous year's allocation and additional allotment releases amounted to P1,555M. Obligations incurred amounted to P1,228M.

Inter-Agency Projects

In addition to the regular program, the agency continued the implementation of the following inter-agency projects:

Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program – Irrigation Component (CARP-IC)

CARP Phase II funded under Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) Agrarian Reform Fund (ARF), with an aggregate cost of P8.5B, started in 1999 and shall be completed in 2008. The project will improve/construct existing CIS and new CIP to irrigate 34,428 ha when fully operational.

For CY 2005, the project targeted 61 CIS/CIP covering 2,838 ha of new area for generation and 2,252 ha for rehabilitation.

At year-end, 449 ha of new areas were generated and 1,359 ha were rehabilitated.

During the year, 14 CIP/CIS were implemented under CARP Phase II and will irrigate about 1,425 ha when fully operational.

Allocation for the year amounted to P321M (P227M from CY 2005 Program and P94M from carry-over fund balances). As of the end of the year, total available allotment amounted to P281M with corresponding cash support of P220M was received. Obligation incurred amounted to P259M.

Agrarian Reform Infrastructure Support Project II (ARISP II)

Partly funded under JBIC loan, the project aims to undertake both infrastructure and institutional components. The infrastructure component deals with the construction of irrigation and drainage facilities and post-harvest facilities to boost agricultural productivity and maximize benefits from agricultural production. While the institutional component deals with the formation of farmers into IA and cooperatives to build viable and self-sustaining communities.

Activities for the year were implemented utilizing also the carry-over fund balances of previous year and CY 2005 allocation amounting to P789M and P350M respectively, or a total of P1,139M.

As of the end of the year, total available allotment is P1,063M with corresponding cash support of P488M.

Correspondingly, 4,069 ha were generated and 2,295 ha rehabilitated on 42 CIS/CIP. Total obligation incurred amounted to P613M.

Twenty-six (26) CIP/CIS under ARISP II were completed. These subprojects will irrigate some 3,980 ha when fully operational.

Agrarian Reform Communities Development Project (ARCDP) Phase II

Funded by the World Bank, ARCDP Phase II is a four-year development project covering 80 Agrarian Reform Communities in 17 provinces with a target service area of 8,300 ha.

This project started in the 2nd quarter of CY 2004. Forty-eight subprojects were identified for pre-engineering activities. For CY 2005, pre-engineering activities are conducted in 28 subprojects. Feasibility studies (FS) in twenty subprojects were completed and 7 are still ongoing. Detailed engineering activities were completed in thirteen of the 20 completed FS. Hence, eleven subprojects are ready for construction.

Total available allotment as of the end of the year amounted to P16M with corresponding cash support of P12M.

Mindanao Sustainable Settlement Area Development Project (MINSSADP)

Funded under the JBIC 25th Yen Loan Program, the Project started in January 2002 and is expected to be completed in December 2007. The project has three components, namely: irrigation development, post-harvest facilities and institutional development. Under these components, farmers will be organized and developed into IA to become effective partners of NIA in irrigation development and boost agricultural production within the DAR selected settlement areas in Regions 10, 11 and 13.

With this project, a total of 25 CIP/CIS, with a total estimated cost of P510.31M, is programmed for construction/rehabilitation. These projects will irrigate some 2,700 ha when fully operational.

As of year-end, feasibility studies on 21 projects were completed and four are still ongoing. Of the 21 projects, 19 were found to be feasible, 1 not feasible and 1 to be deferred. Detailed engineering for 14 of the 19 projects were completed. Construction is already ongoing for 3 projects. Total available allotment for the year was P65.8M (P65.2M from CY 2005 Program and P0.6M from carry-over funds). Correspondingly, this amount was supported with cash/non-cash of P55.7M. Obligation incurred was P26.2M.

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

SYSTEMS OPERATION

Operation and Maintenance (O&M) of NIS and CIS

The Agency operated and maintained an aggregate service area of 695,774 ha for NIS. The irrigated area for CY 2005 totaled 972,692 ha broken down into 496,242 ha and 476,450 ha for wet and dry crops, respectively. The irrigation cropping intensity attained was 140 percent. This is an increase of 6% or 6,227 ha of irrigated lands compared with CY 2004 for NIS alone. Benefited areas were 463,702 ha and 441,052 ha for wet and dry seasons, respectively.

As of year end, total service area of CIS was 543,262 ha. The total irrigated area was 558,598 ha (291,891 ha during wet season and 266,707 ha during the dry season), with 102% irrigation cropping intensity. Thus, the total irrigated area in both wet and dry seasons for NIS and CIS is 1,531,290 has.

Several projects are being implemented to improve the O&M of various NIS and CIS. Two projects are foreign-assisted: the Bago River Irrigation System Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (BRISRIP) in Negros Occidental and the Irrigation Systems Improvement Project II (ISIP II) in Northern Leyte. Three nationwide projects are locally-funded: the Balikatan Sagip Patubig Program (BSPP), the Repair/Rehabilitation of Existing NIS (RRENIS) and the Repair and Establishment of Groundwater Irrigation Projects (REGIP).

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

Management Action Plan: Updating of Management Records of NIS

The Agency, in its efforts to improve its operations and ISF collection efficiency in all NIS, conducted and completed the Management Action Plan (MAP). This involved the updating of management records of NIS, such as Irrigation Fee Register (IFR), Watermaster Masterlists (WM) and Parcellary Map (PM). The activity aimed to firm-up the service areas of NIS. Updated IFR, WM and PM would allow a systematic and effective monitoring of seasonal irrigated, benefited and billed areas for a more efficient ISF billing and collection efficiency.

As of year-end, the firm-ed-up service area (FUSA) of NIS was 689,375 ha. Some 128,200 ha were found to be not irrigated due to defective facilities. These areas will be programmed for future repair and rehabilitation to restore irrigated areas and consequently increase ISF collection.

Sustainable System of Irrigated Agriculture (SSIA)

The NIA continued to disseminate information on the SSIA farming technology. The SSIA is a “3-in-1” farming technique, using less water, more production yet environment friendly. This scheme will enhance rice production, increase income of farmers, thus improving the paying capacity of farmers.

INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

The organization and development of farmer-beneficiaries were continuously undertaken nationwide to facilitate implementation of irrigation development and management. Trainings were conducted to increase the capabilities of farmer-beneficiaries in O&M of the facilities that are turned over to them as well as in running the affairs of their association. Irrigators Association (IA) Trainings and Conferences were conducted and participated in by 19,006 irrigation beneficiaries.

During the year, 140 IA were organized with an area of 18,924 ha in NIS and CIS involving 15,951 farmers. Of these, 61 IA in 7,325 ha in NIS and CIS involving 9,056 farmers were registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). There were 1,549 new IA which signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with NIA for the operation and maintenance of irrigation systems.

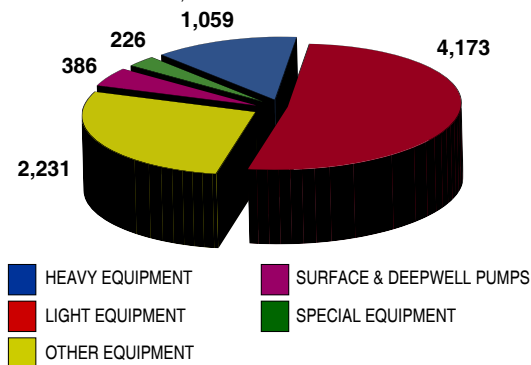

EQUIPMENT MANAGEMENT

The Agency was able to maintain in reliable operating condition some 3,741 units of heavy, light transport and other support equipment including special equipment like irrigation pumps in support to the O&M and/or rehabilitation of NIS and construction of both national and communal irrigation projects. The total inventory as of year-end was 8,075 units as illustrated below:

As of December 31, 2005



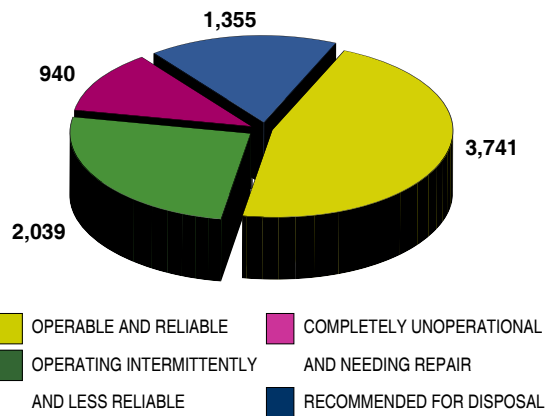
Of the total inventory, 3,741 or 46% are in good and reliable operating condition, 2,039 units or 25% are less reliable and operating intermittently, 940 units or 12% are completely unoperational and needing repair and 1,355 units or 17% are recommended for disposal.

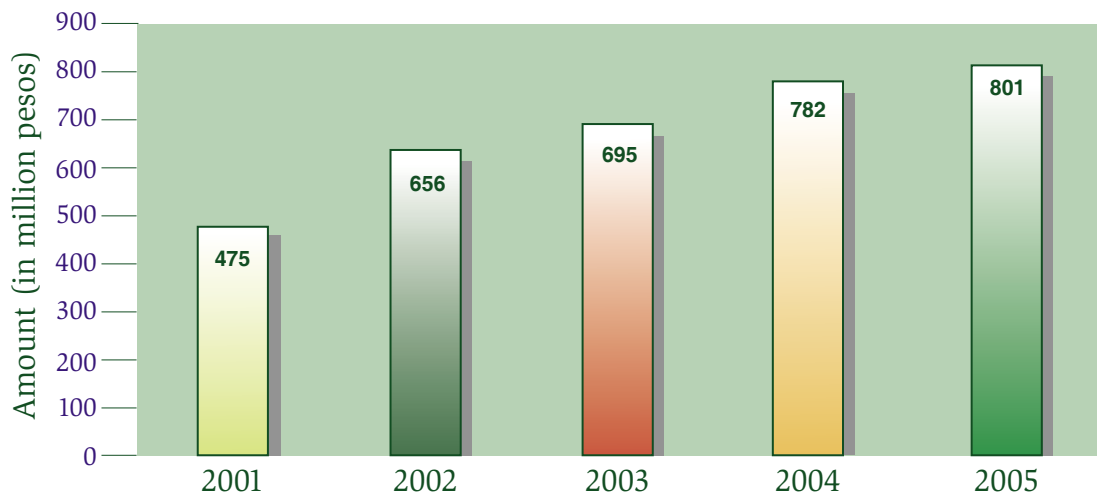

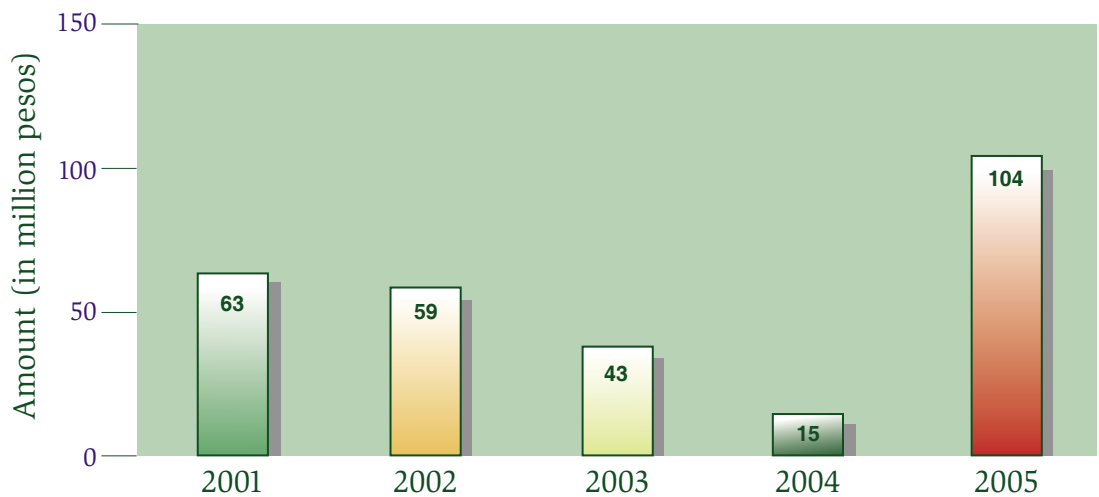
NIA continuously intensified its efforts to generate revenues and apply cost-saving measures to sustain its financial condition.

For CY 2005, NIA's total revenues reached P1,629M, an increase of P205.8M from the CY 2004 level of P1,423M. Likewise, total expenditures increased by P116M from P1,409M in CY 2004 to P1,525M in CY 2005. NIA posted a net operating income of P104M.

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

• Career Executive Service

NIA has in its fold a number of officials and employees with CESO, CESE and CSEE. NIA management recognizes the leadership potentials of these people wherein some of them were appointed either to third level positions or to the top ranking positions in NIA.

• Manpower Complement

The austerity program prescribed under Administrative Order No. 103 was strictly implemented by NIA to reduce costs on personal services which correspondingly trimmed down the manpower complement.

The NIA's overall manpower complement as of year-end is 9,186 broken down as follows: 5,661 for monthly and daily employees charged against COB and 3,525 for Project-charged employees.

• Legal Services

The Agency continued to pursue its mandate of extending legal services to various offices in the central and field offices. Activities undertaken were the review and processing of civil works and supply contracts, right-of-way claims and memorandum of agreements. Legal opinions/advices were rendered on various legal queries from the different offices of the Agency. Civil cases were initiated in court in coordination with appropriate government agencies.





• **Human Resources Development**

The National Irrigation Administration continued to administer trainings and seminars aimed at developing the skills of its employees and farmer-beneficiaries, nationwide.

NIA has carried out 34 technical courses and 12 non-technical courses that benefited 771 employees coming from the rank and file, supervisory and managerial levels. Forty-six NIA employees participated in five external trainings undertaken by partner agencies.

Eleven deserving employees had availed foreign study grants sponsored by various international organizations. All these programs were geared in enhancing the manpower competencies of the Agency to ensure responsiveness to the current needs of public service as well as efficiency in its delivery.

As regards capability-building activities for farmer-beneficiaries, NIA has carried out trainings for IA nationwide.

Aside from the aforesaid undertakings, NIA also continued to carry out its Apprenticeship Program and has accommodated a total of 50 students from various colleges and universities nationwide.

PROCUREMENT AND PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

The Agency continued to implement reforms in procurement in accordance with RA 9184 to ensure efficiency and transparency in all stages of the procurement process. All offices nationwide submitted an Annual Procurement Plan on time and updated Bids and Awards Committees. Employees directly involved in procurement as BAC members, Secretariat and Technical Working Group are sent to seminars/training on RA 9184.

NIA enhanced its services for a better physical assets management under the New Government Accounting System (NGAS) adopting prescribed forms and codes in the inventory reporting; updating of Ledger Cards, Invoice Receipts and Acknowledgement Receipts; registration and insurance of vehicles and buildings; and issuance/shipment of supplies and equipment to field offices remain regular activities. NIA has generated an income of P8.5M from the sale of unserviceable equipment, obsolete spare parts and waste materials, including old warehouses at MAS Compound, Port Area. The NIA ceased operation of the Compound after turning it over to the Philippine Ports Authority in December 2005.

The upkeep, beautification and cleanliness program of NIA facilities and compound were regularly undertaken to provide employees with a healthy and pleasant environment. Face lifting activities at the NIA Building Complex, that included the renovation of restrooms at IEC Bldg., and construction of the new Multi-Purpose Court which is scheduled for completion early next year were undertaken.

NIA supported the Energy Conservation Program of the government by implementing energy conservation measures and monitoring the consumption of electricity, fuel and water. Utilization is reduced by almost 10% in all offices during the first month of the Program and continues to improve thereafter. The Department of Energy recognized our strong commitment and support to the endeavor by giving NIA an impressive grade of 90% in its "National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Program in Government Buildings". The Certificate of Recognition was received by Administrator Baltazar H. Usis from Senior Deputy Executive Secretary Waldo Flores from the Office of the President on November 8, 2005.

ORGANIZATION AND MANAGEMENT

Management Services

The Agency continued the processing and evaluation of request for authority to fill up vacant positions as well as request for extension/creation of daily positions coming from different offices of NIA based on existing guidelines. Organization audit was also undertaken in Balog- Balog Multipurpose Project during the first semester of CY 2005 which resulted in the reduction of manpower requirement.

In compliance with Executive Order No. 366 issued by the Office of the President of the Republic of the Philippines, the Agency started to draft its Rationalization Plan thru series of workshops among NIA Sub-Change Management Team. The team is composed of all NIA Top Management Officials, Department Managers, Regional/Operations Managers and representative from the employees association, the NIAEASP and from other professional groups in the Agency.

The draft Rationalization Plan was disseminated to all key regional staff nationwide aimed at clarifying frequently asked questions and to gather feedbacks, comments and recommendations to improve the draft RP.

Management Audit

A comprehensive Audit of cash and cash accounts of all accountable officers was intensified. It covered review in the issuance of cash advances, disbursements, ISF cash collections and other financial transactions. A total of seven (7) Regions with thirty-eight (38) Provincial Offices, fifty-seven (57) National Systems and four (4) District Offices including one (1) Dam and Reservoir division were visited by the three groups of Management Audit Team. A review of equipment utilization/rental and related matters was likewise conducted in Regions 1 and 4.

The issuance of MC nos. 34 and 40 s 2004 strengthened internal control. With the issuance of DBM Budget Circular No. 2004-4 in which the thrust is to strengthen Internal Audit of all Government Agencies, a two-week seminar/workshop cum on-the-job application on Cash Examination for all Senior/Management Analysts (a.k.a. Internal Auditors) was conducted on June 28-July 8, 2005. The training contributed significantly in the improvement of Internal Control System of the NIA nationwide.





PROGRAM THRUSTS FOR CY 2006

Consistent with the Medium-Term Philippine Development Plan 2004-2010, NIA will pursue various activities in line with the strategy to make food plentiful at competitive prices and reduce the cost of priority “wage” goods. The priority programs in 2006 are focused on the following thrusts:

- Sustained O&M of existing systems
- Fast tracking of the rehabilitation and improvement of existing irrigation systems
- Intensification of the ISF collection to generate more funds for O&M
- Acceleration of Irrigation Management Transfer and IA Development
- Acceleration of the completion of ongoing projects
- Implementation of new projects with approved loans/grants and assured funding support only
- Small-scale, labor intensive irrigation projects
- Maximum use of equipment to support O&M
- Introduction of programs on rehabilitation, conservation and protection of critical irrigation watersheds

Under its regular program, NIA envisions to generate 11,200 ha of new areas for irrigation and restore irrigation service to 54,870 ha in existing systems. Some P4,313M will be needed to pursue the implementation of eight (8) foreign-assisted projects and nine (9) locally-funded projects and conduct of feasibility studies and detailed engineering of various projects. About 62% of this amount represents loan proceeds and 38% local counterparts.

In collaboration with the Department of Agrarian Reform, the Agency’s physical targets for the development of Agrarian Reform Communities include the generation of 12,120 ha of new areas and restoration of irrigation service in 4,090 ha amounting P380M. Majority of these areas will be in CIP/CIS and systems that are programmed under the CARP-IC Phase II funded under DAR’s ARF, ARISP II and Agrarian Reform Community Development Project Phase 2 (ARCDP II).

In addition, NIA will start a three-year rehabilitation program of NIS and CIS nationwide during the year in support of the government’s rice self-sufficiency goal by 2009. The program entails the rehabilitation of some 368,000 ha in both NIS and CIS at a cost of P22,084 M and sustenance of NIS areas in the amount of P2,794M, or a total of P24,878M.
