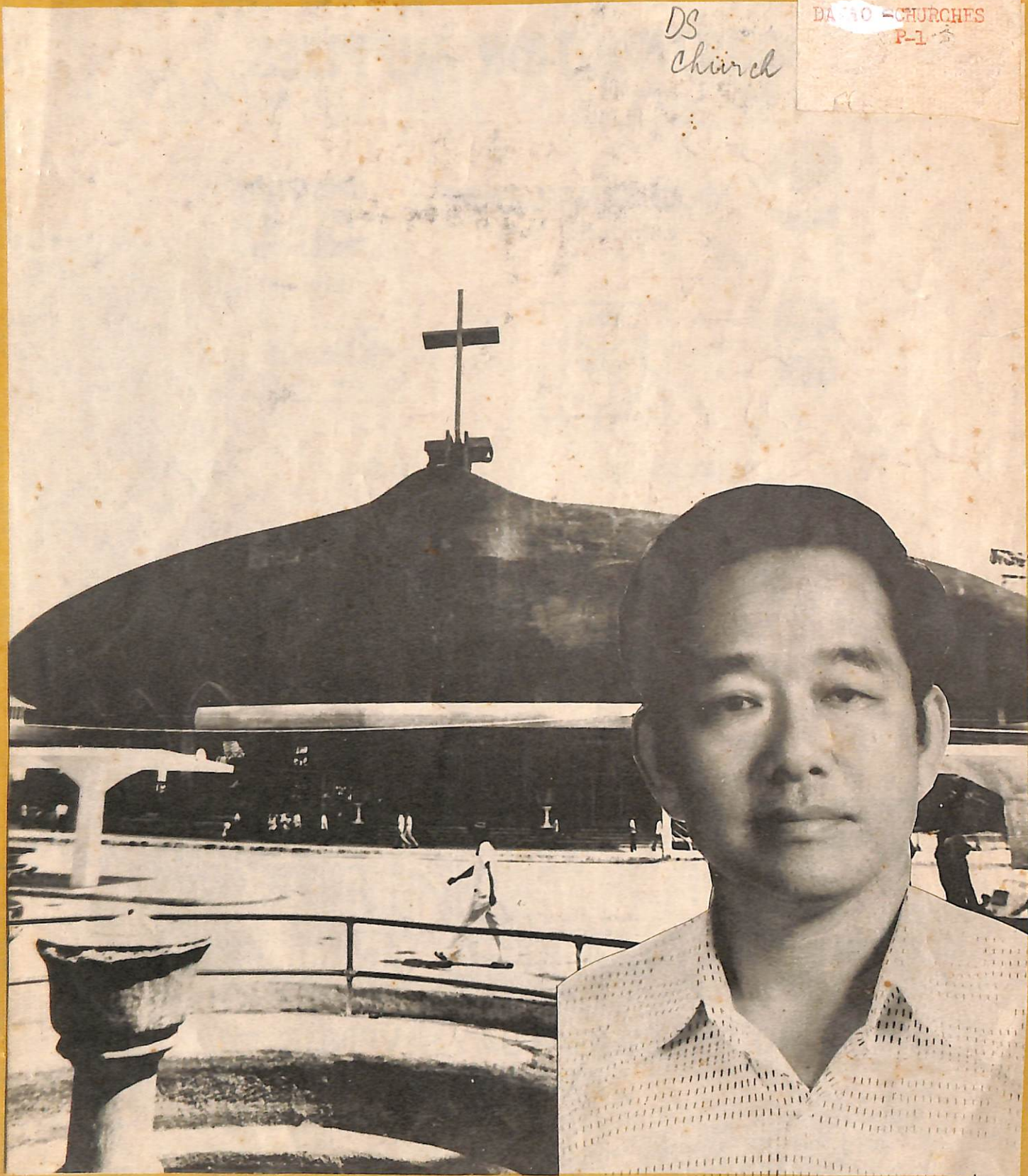

CHANGING THE DAVAO SKYLINE



Manuel N. Chiew
Architect, Builder, Artist

Maning Chiew, that's how his friends call him, that's how he likes to be called, says he started out life in reverse. And though he has strongly Oriental features, that's not being inscrutable in his case. Where most start out as architects and end up as building contractors, Maning started out as a building contractor and ended up an architect.

That was back in 1954, when he set up Manuel N. Chiew Associates, a construction firm. He was two years out of college, with a BS in Civil Engineering degree from the Mapua Institute of Tech-

Somehow along the line, sometime in the late 1960's he tried to take stock of himself, decided that he didn't want to be just another successful building contractor, and went back to school.

He took his BS in Architecture degree from the University of Mindanao in 1971 and passed the board examination for architects in 1972. He wasted no time, set up Manuel N. Chiew, Architects the same year the government gave him the right to practice his craft.

Contracts and awards came fast and easy. Cited for academic excellence in his second, third and

fourth years at the UM School of Architecture, the new architect was willing to tackle any assignment.

Where newer architects would have feared to tread, Maning dared to walk on new and uncharted ground. A good example was his willingness to take on the design of the San Pedro Cathedral early in his architectural careers.

The then parish priest of San Pedro wanted a cathedral shaped along modernistic lines and had rejected more traditional proposals. When the offer came his way, he

seized it.

The design he proposed was accepted. Quite a number of people were shocked at what he had conceived. But acceptance has grown through the years and what once was occasion for controversy is now a landmark. And as witness the fund drive to complete it, people have taken pride in it.

The Catholic cathedral along Davao's main street expresses a lot of what Maning says when he

describes himself as a "modernist." The semi-circular shape he prescribed in a drastic revision of traditional church architecture characterized by straight lines, columns and rising spires and even towers. As he likes to emphasize in all his designs, what he sought was what was appropriate for the land on which the building was to be situated.

There are no columns in the cathedral design and every churchgoer no matter how far back he is

enjoys the same perspective of the altar. And in Maning's own right fully proud words "in a semi-circle everybody from the rear is equidistant to the center." And more: "There is no one point of emphasis. Even if you bisect it, it remains symmetrically balanced. We repeat the same design for each portion." And though he doesn't mention it, there is enough reason to believe that in his traditional symmetry and in his bold experimental forms are good bases on

which theology and architecture may have reached a happy blend.

Maning has done other churches for other denominations. The Church of God along Palma Gil Street in his. As is the slightly traditional (except for the position of the bell tower, another modernist touch design of the Davao Evangelical Church along Jacinto Extension.

But big and small projects crowd his working table.

The list of residences he's worked on fills a whole page of his brochure. For this type of work, however, Maning disdains refer-

ence to a particular style. "Be receptive" is the precept he observes in discussing plans with his clients. Receptiveness he qualifies to mean carefully considering the client's requirements. Following this, he goes into translating and interpreting requirements into architectural forms.

And though claims to a style may not form a part of the passions of Maning Chiew, the fact remains that people continue to recommend him. For houses. For offices.

Even as far north as Manila where he's done a number of residences. And Quezon City where he

has a big project going, a corporation office building.

But bigness is something that's never fazed him. In his own words: "The practice of architecture has changed in many ways. The demands of people now are more complex. Many now demand a project

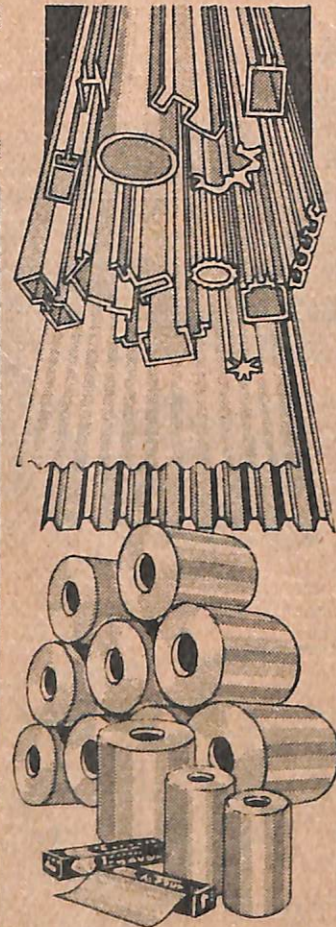

So the architect now has to come up with a total design. He has to coordinate with the civil engineer. The sanitary engineer. The electrical engineer. The interior designer. The landscape architect. Yes, he has to coordinate with them to come up with the total design. The architect in this sense is the *prime professional*. As such, Maning adds "only the architect is equipped with the proper training in building technology. Also with the proper experience to guide him through the entire process of construction."

As prime professional, Maning knows that he, as architect in command. It is he who sees the totality of the project. Just as it is he who sees to it that the project bears a distinctive stamp.

A big project typical of this is the campus of the University of Southern Mindanao in Kabacan. Maning is consulting architect for the campus building complex. And while each building in the complex is designed for its own particular uses, Maning has managed to inject what we feel will be the standout feature. This is the Malayan-inspired motif that he has caused to be imprinted on every building.

There is continuous search for the contemporary Philippine architecture," Maning holds, adding that the Malayan motif is typical of the approach that he follows: "It is possible, however, to take elements of Philippine culture and to put these together and have these add up to something Philippine."

The sarimanok motif he has caused to be imprinted on precast sections of walls, having these repeated in a fascinating visual series. Chevron designs will also run along the eaves of the roof line. And, as a final touch, the sarimanok will be bursting out in full feather at the beams.

At this point, there's no telling where the Chiew hand and eye will fall next. Each year typically presents not only a new challenge but a new set of challenges. But as surely as the Davao skyline changes we can be sure this man will have had his own touch appended, almost as if he were taking part in a new creation.

But that is what an architect is, the prime professional, the one who coordinates all others in the making of structures. Such as Maning Chiew is. And will be.

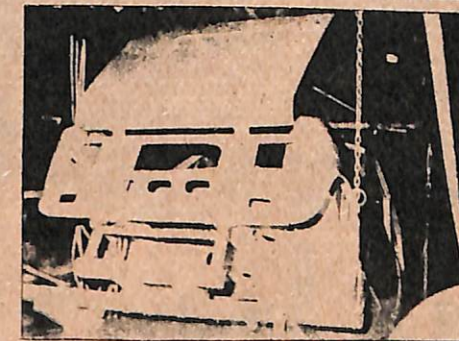
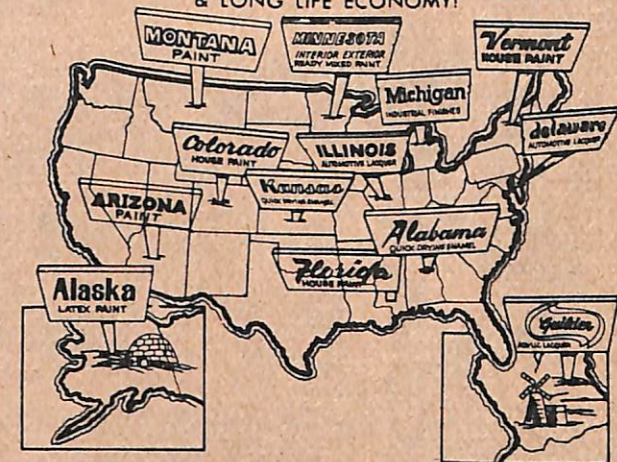
