Overview of the Regional Economy

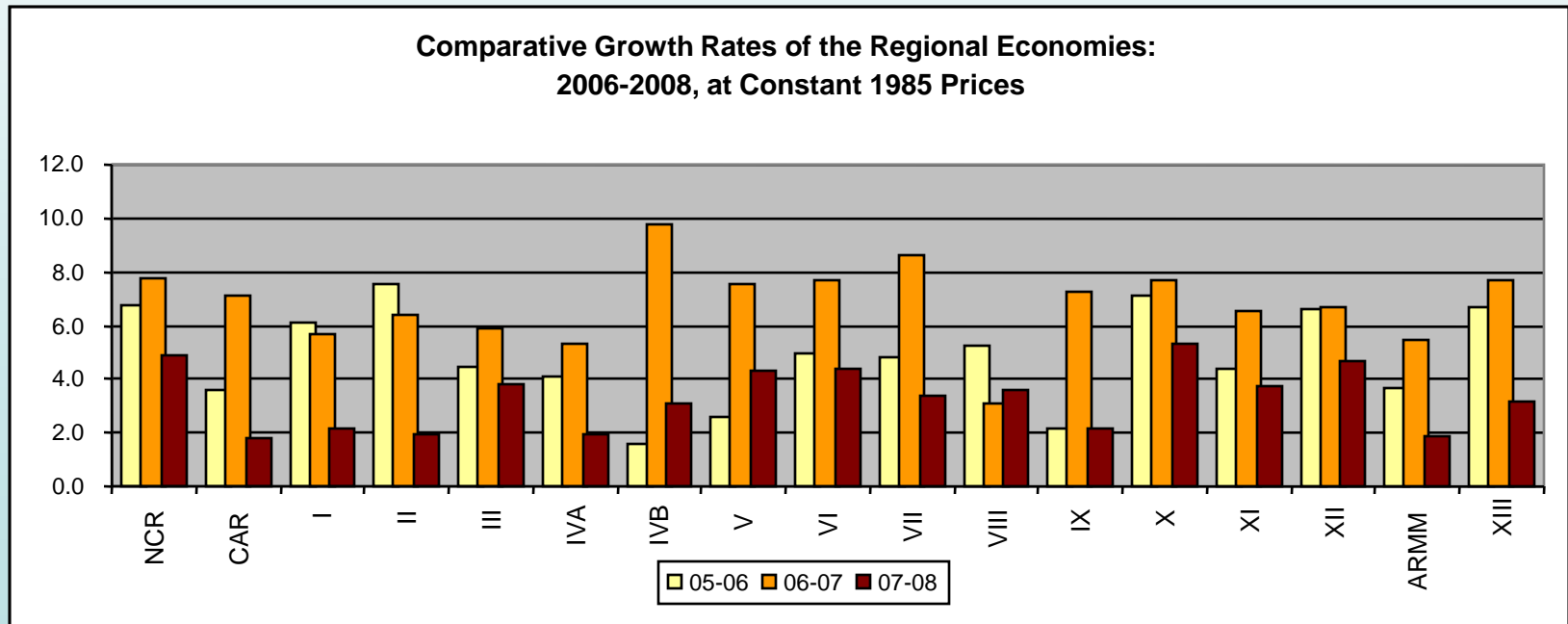




Regional Economy

(Growth rates, in percent)

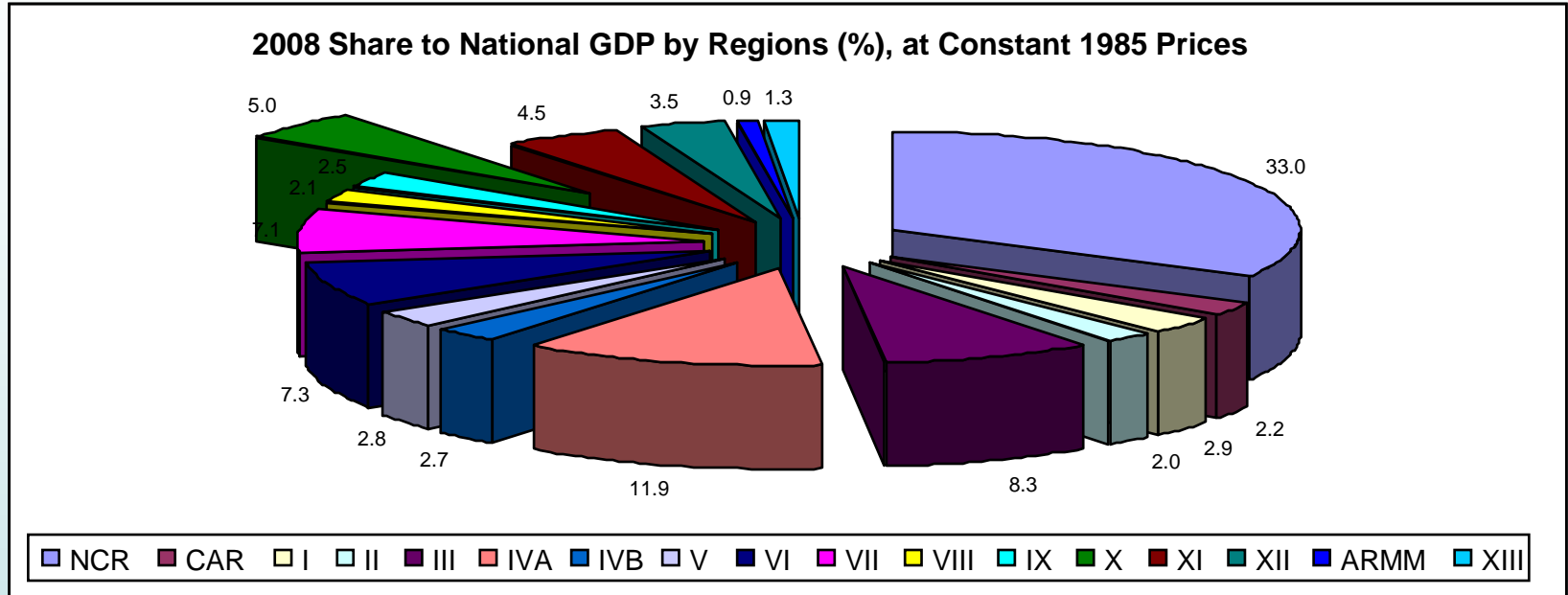
Northern Mindanao is the fastest growing economy in 2008

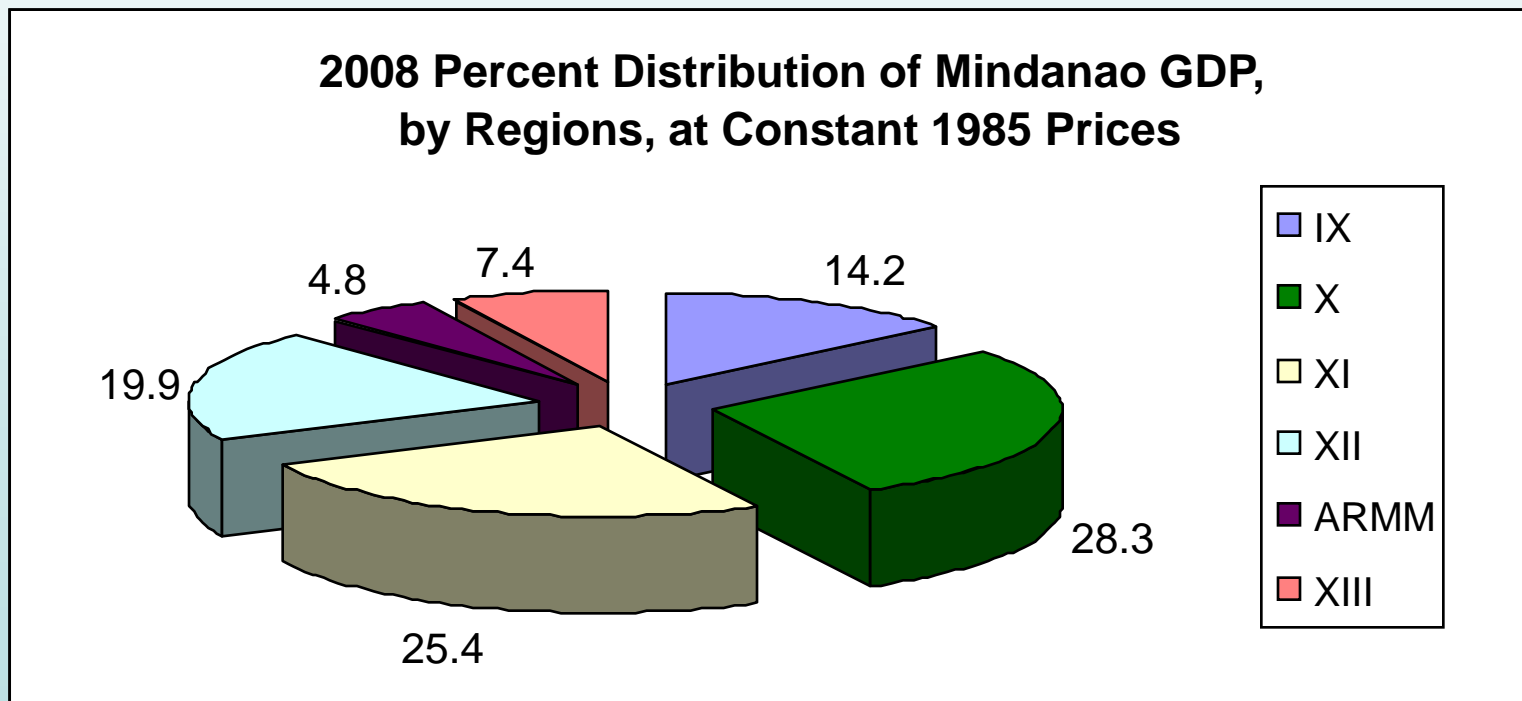




Northern Mindanao & Mindanao

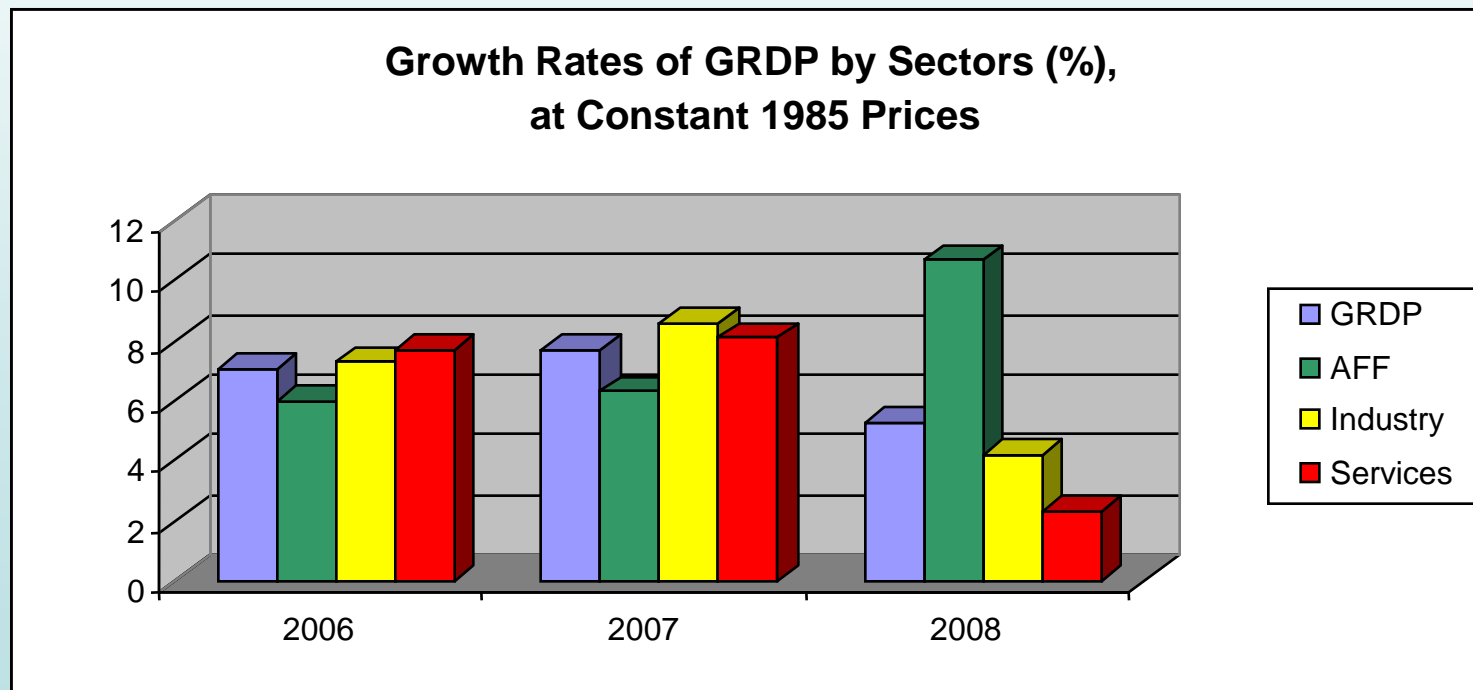

(Growth rates, in percent)

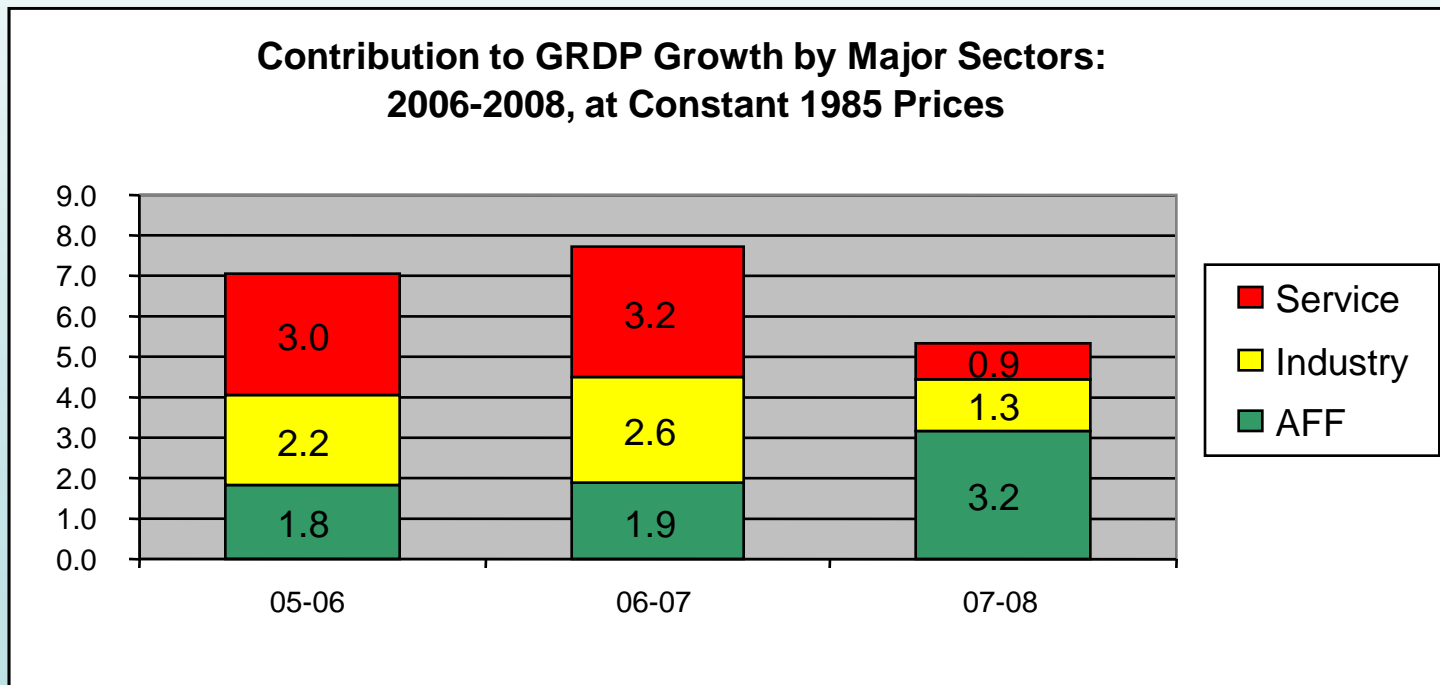
Agriculture recorded the largest expansion among sectors in 2008

Agriculture provided the highest contribution to regional growth



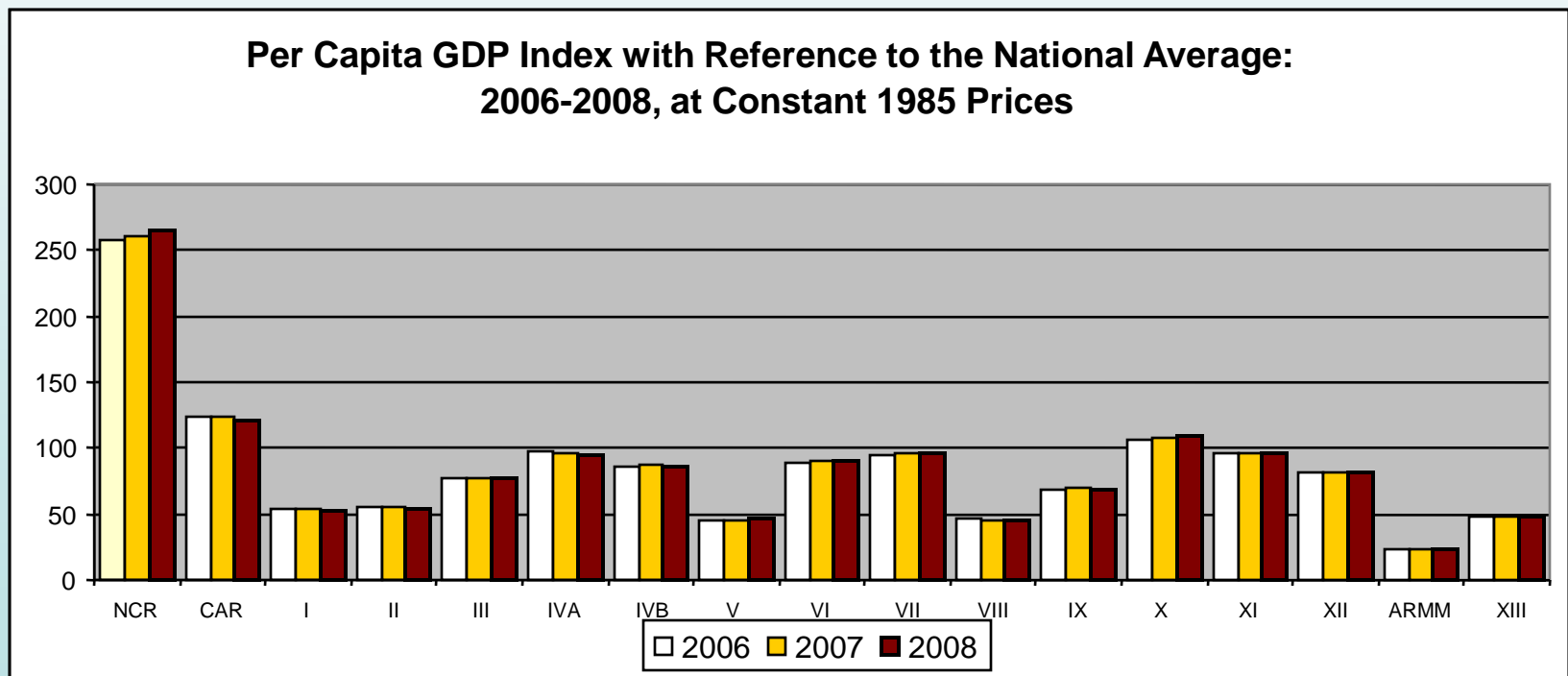


Per Capita GRDP

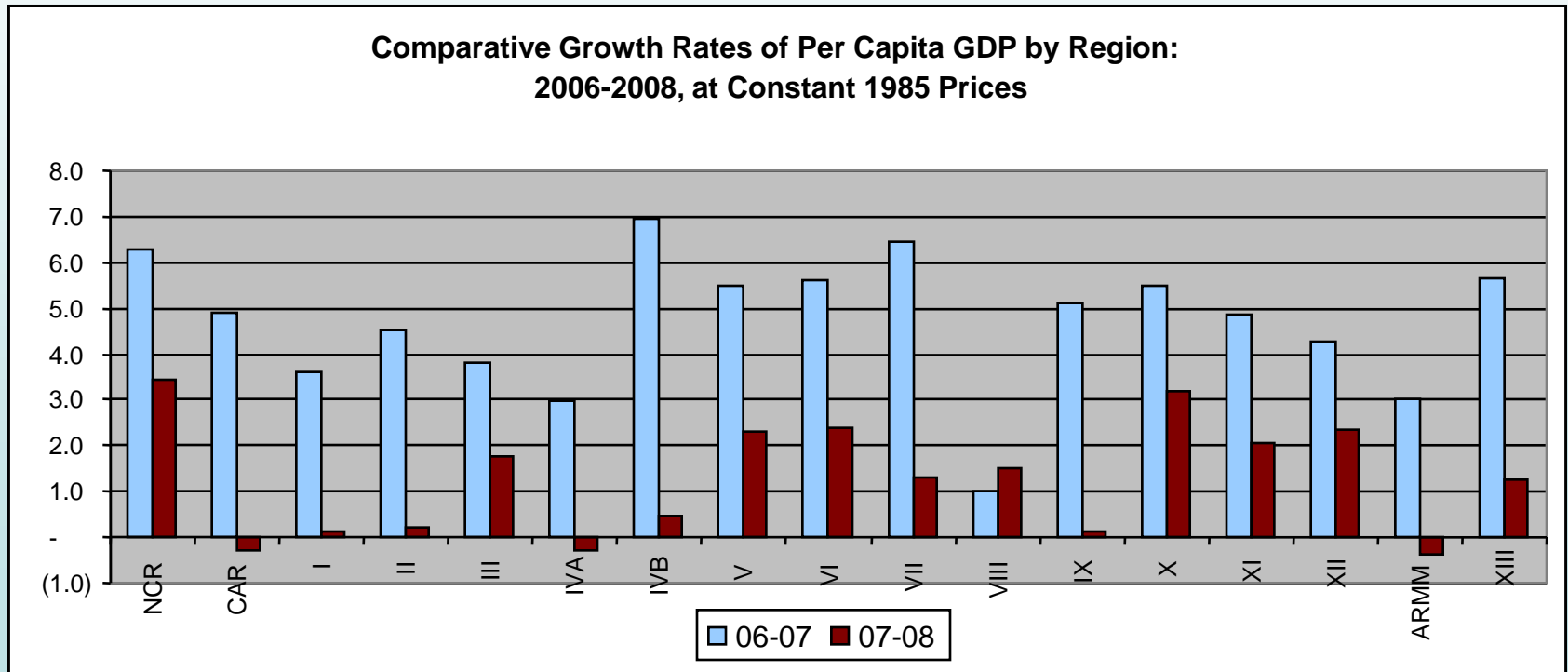




Northern Mindanao sustained to be the 3rd highest per capita GRDP

Structure of the Regional Economy

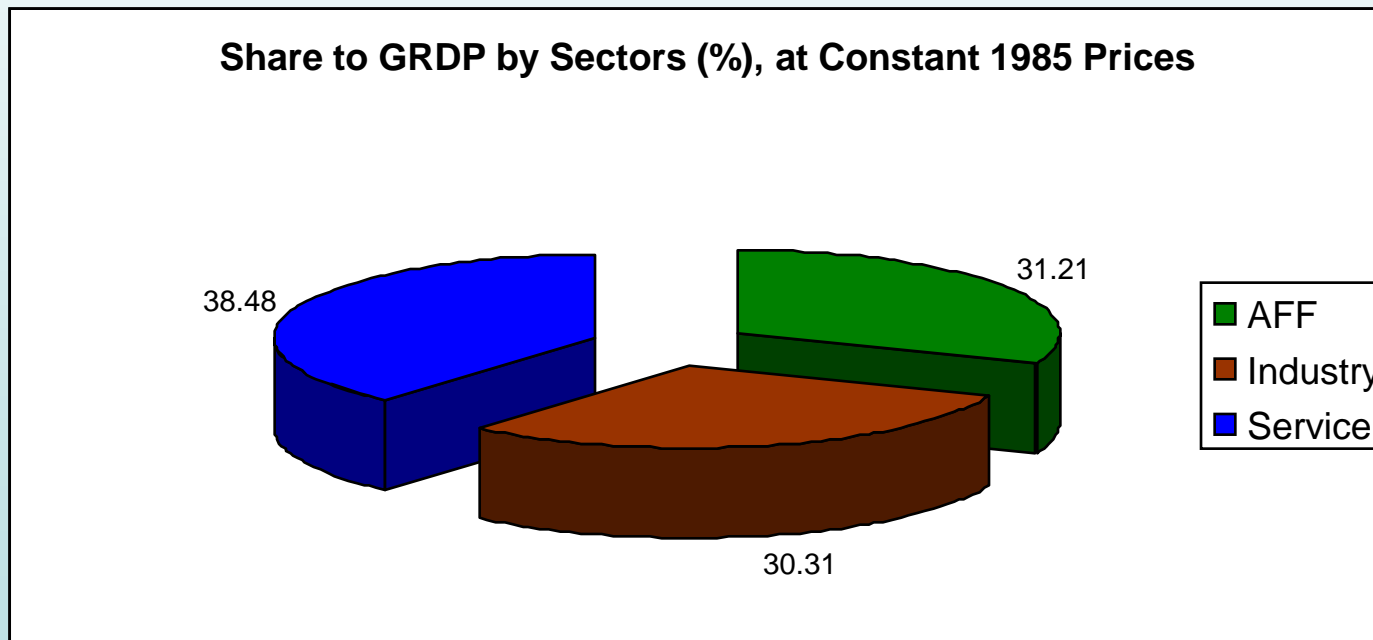

The Service sector is the largest sector in the region

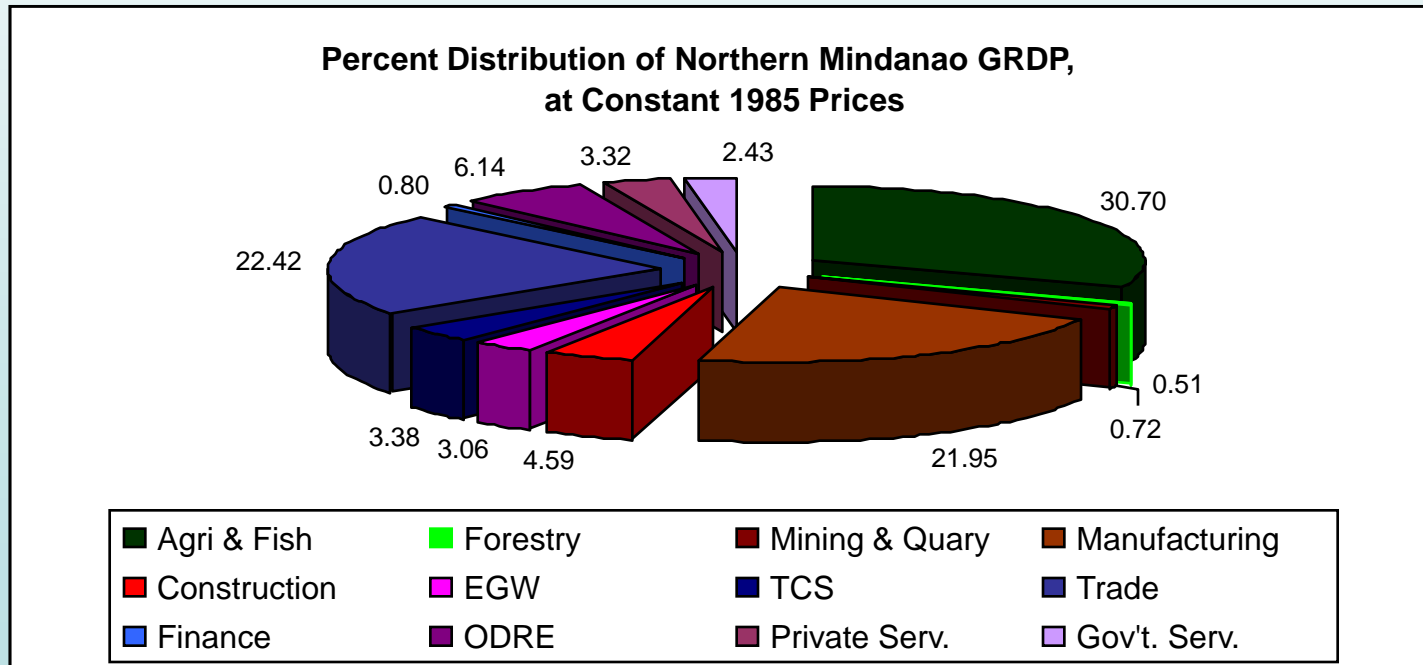

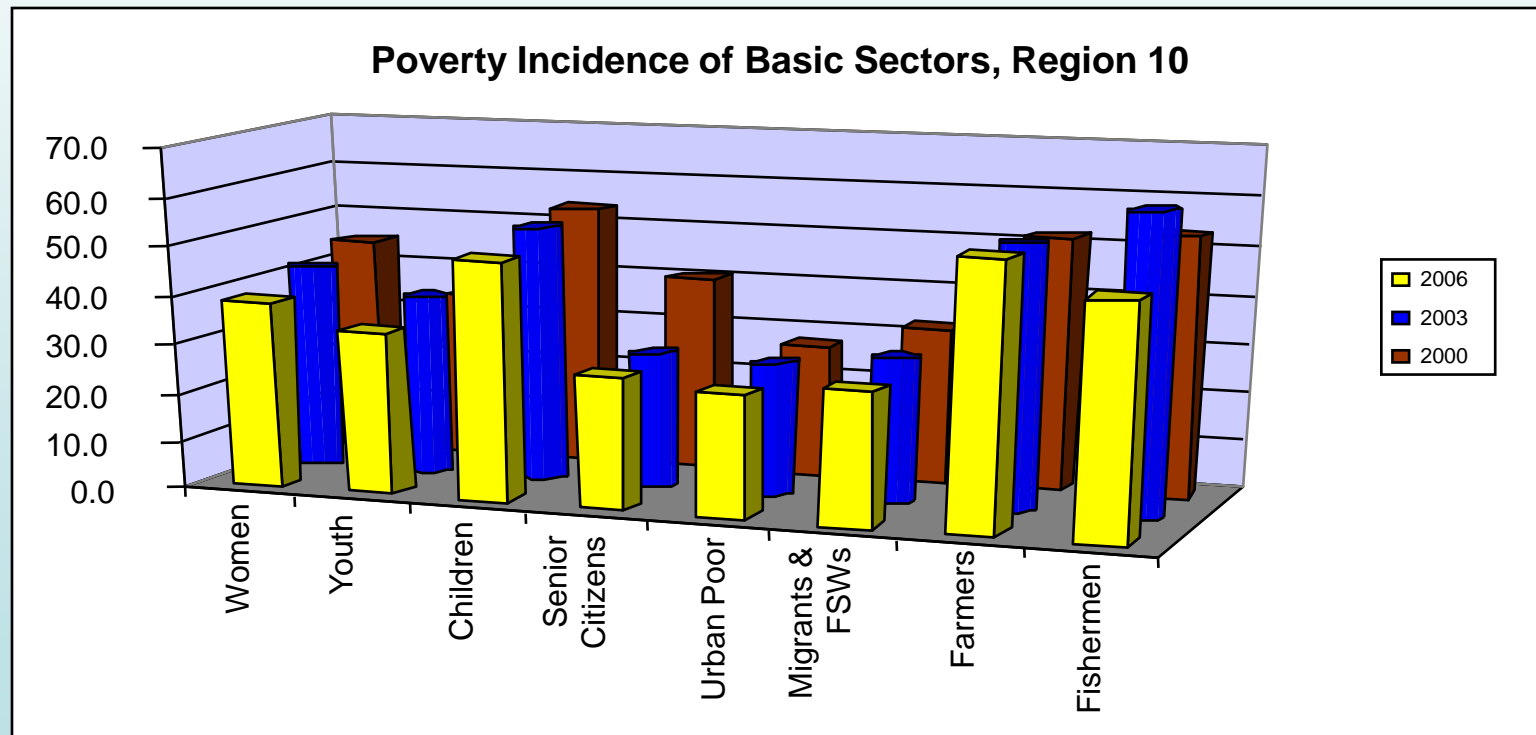
Poverty Incidence, 2003

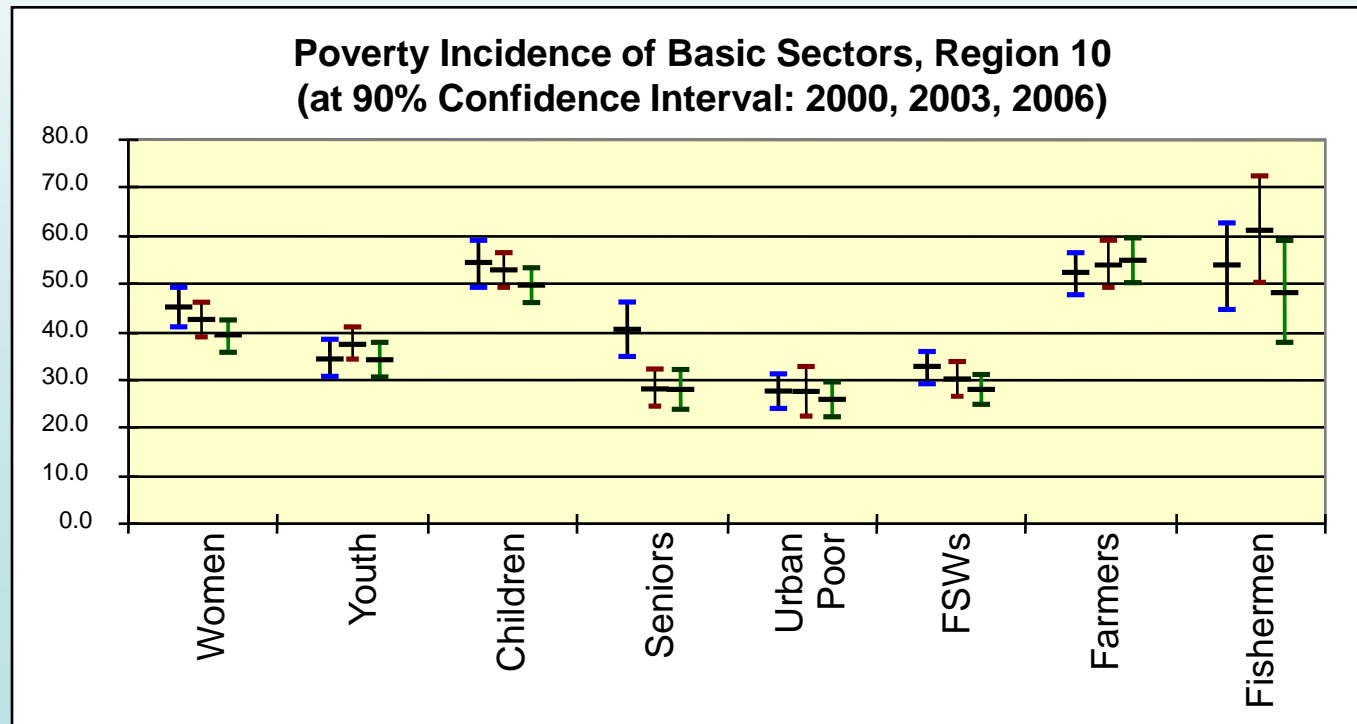


Farmers and Fishermen are the poorest sector in the region

**1% increase in per Capita GRDP
will decrease poverty incidence by
0.1794%**

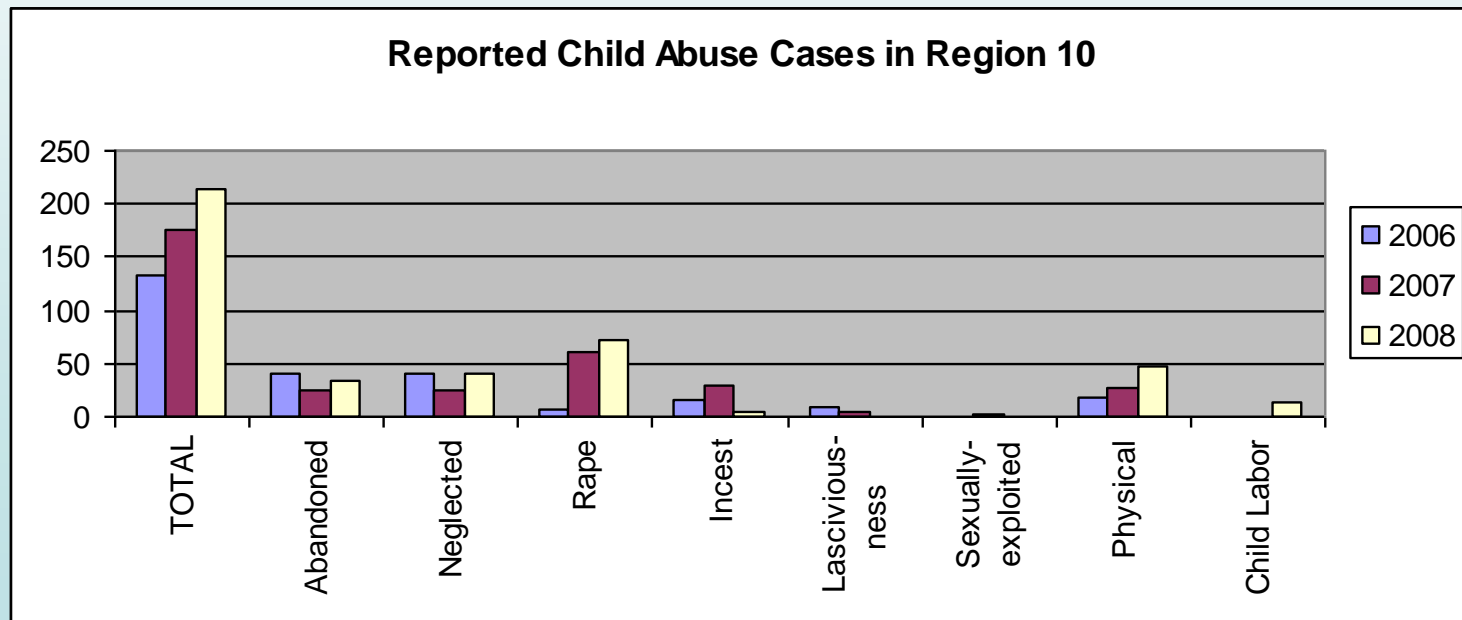

Crime Against Children

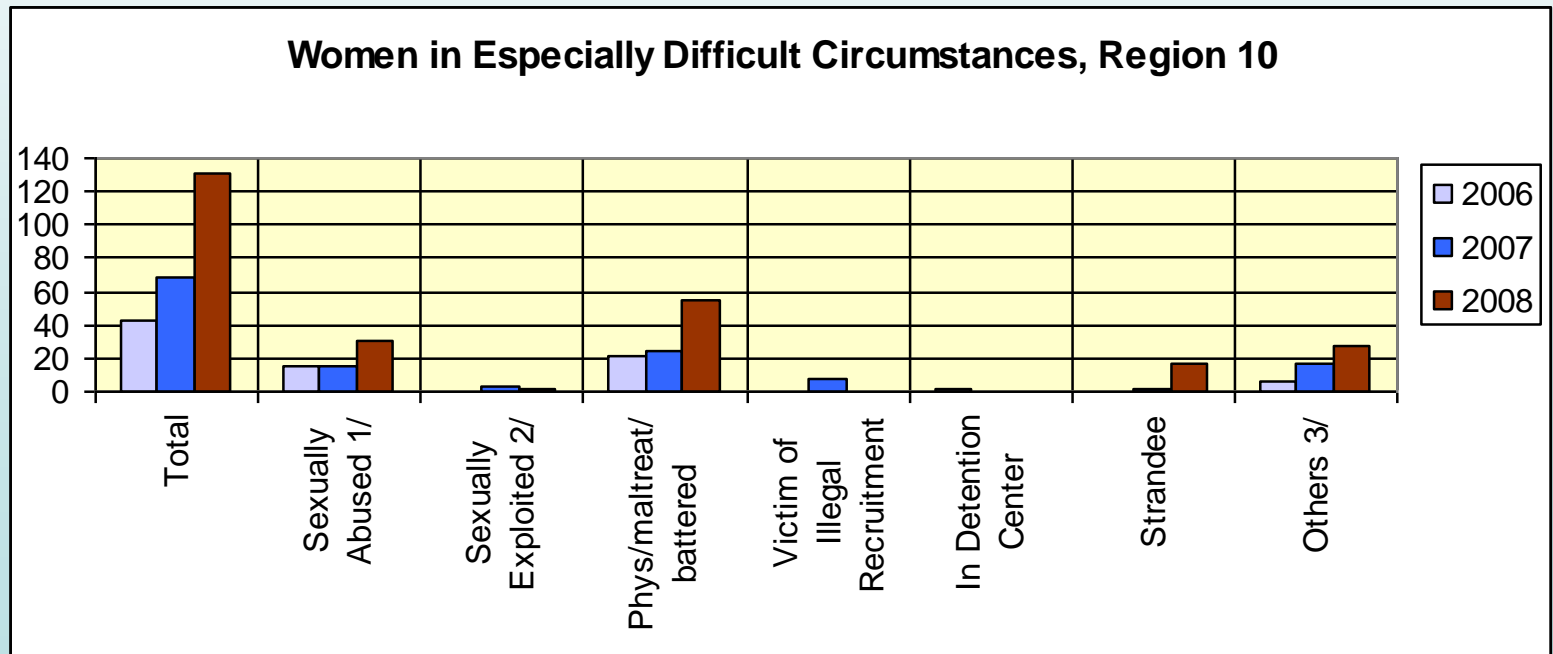
Amidst improvement in over-all crime situation, reported crime against children is still increasing...

Challenges

- Data Availability:
 - Statistics on security, either economic, man-made or natural, remains under-developed and/or unshared.
- Measurement Methodology
 - Measurement remains “post-hoc”. Challenges remains in forecasting, especially in measuring “**vulnerability**”.
